Scholarship Application Deadline: Feb 15, 2018

IPSI awards a limited number of merit-and need based scholarships

- Scholarship applicants are encouraged to carefully prepare the necessary documents to maximize their chances of being selected among our large pool of applicants
- Scholarship applicants are permitted to apply to ONE Symposium per year; if you choose to apply for a scholarship to the Sarajevo Symposium, you are not permitted to also apply for the Washington DC Symposium.
- Scholarships are for tuition costs only. Under no circumstances does IPSI provide scholarships for travel, visa costs, accommodations, or lodging in Sarajevo.

Criteria:

- Be currently enrolled in a Rotary Peace Center Program as a Rotary Peace Fellow
- Be an Alumni of a Rotary Peace Center Program as a Rotary Peace Fellow

Richard Goldstone Scholarship

Standard Tuition: 2,999 USD **Scholarship Value:** **800 USD**

TOTAL tuition costs paid by scholarship recipient: **2,199 USD**

Criteria:

- Be between the ages of 22-35;
- Currently be studying or working on issues of peace and security
- Having lived in a conflict or post-conflict country for a minimum of five years
- Demonstrate financial need

Information requested as part of application:

- Statement of Purpose (maximum of 300 words) describing why you are uniquely suited to utilize IPSI's trainings to foster peace and security.
- 2 References
- You may be asked to provide a Statement of Financial Need at a later point of the selection process.
